Eclipse Debuts ImageUtilities add-on for EclipseSuite

Eclipse Data Technologies of Pleasanton, CA has introduced ImageUtilities, an add-on module to their popular EclipseSuite premastering system.

Key to ImageUtilities are the main-channel and sub-channel sector viewers. These viewers are linked to the EclipseSuite programs and allow the user to 'drill down' to underlying data.

"Eclipse originally focused on introducing expert level, user-friendly tools," stated Kevin McDonnell, President of Eclipse "but, as EclipseSuite becomes the primary tool for our customers, they are asking for access the to raw data. This is especially useful for understanding many of the sub-channel problems that occur during mastering."

ImageUtilities contains several other useful tools, such as a DDP Browser, ISRC/UPC/Master ID editor, and some tape utilities.

EclipseSuite was introduced at Replitech in San Jose this year. It is a software-based premastering system containing a powerful analysis engine that utilizes user-settable rules and exclusions. Main and sub channel data are checked for compliance to CD Books and formats. All Books and formats are supported, including multisession and DVD. It reports gapping and timing violations, 3rd layer errors, and uncorrectable audio errors. Coupled with the ImageVerify and ImageCopy data conversion module, it is a complete premastering system.
