Eclipse Adds Macrovision Support to EclipseSuite

Eclipse has added support for identification of Macrovision protected images to its EclipseSuite premastering and verification tools.

The feature allows DVD manufacturing plants to meet specific Macrovision process requirements. These requirements include:

- 1. Replicators must ask rights owners if the masters they provide are Macrovision protected.
- 2. If the rights owner says the program is protected, the replicator is to check Macrovision's list of rights owner licensees to make sure the rights owner is Macrovision-licensed prior to commencing replication.
- 3. The replicator is to check one disc from any new title after replication to determine if it is Macrovision copy protected.
- 4. The replicator must report volumes of copy protected discs, by title, back to Macrovision.

Eclipse's ImageAnalysis provides the ability to quickly analyze DLT source tapes and DVD replicates. ImageVerify allows for comparison of a DVD source tape to a replica. As with all EclipseSuite products, images are fully analyzed for DVD book compliance. The presence of Macrovision is reported along with other format information such as DVD-5, DVD-9, opposite or parallel track path, region code, and CSS encryption.

Eclipse develops mastering, premastering, and QC verification tools for the CD and DVD manufacturing industry.
