Eclipse Adds Remote Job Scheduler

With the continued success of its ImageEncoder mastering interface, Eclipse has added a Remote Job Scheduler to their product line.

Remote Scheduler provides a seamless network interface between a remote ImageCopy and one or more ImageEncoders in mastering. This allows you to copy an image to a local or networked hard drive, direct it to a specific LBR, and enter mastering parameters and graphics band information from Premastering. You can also monitor a job's mastering status and remotely open log files to get more detailed mastering information.

Job queues are available for pending jobs as well as already mastered jobs. The pending job queue can be reprioritized with a simple 'drag and drop'. Because Remote Scheduler uses ImageCopy as its copy engine, every image is fully analyzed for format compliance as it is copied. Up to four images can be copied into the job queue simultaneously.

Remote Scheduler is fully compliant with Eclipse's newly released ImageIntegrity module. ImageIntegrity can automatically verify that images are copied correctly. It also utilizes checksums to ensure data is not corrupted as it moves across a network.

Eclipse develops mastering, premastering, and QC verification tools for the CD and DVD manufacturing industry.
